Galleria Torbandena will organize in its two exhibition spaces an important retrospective dedicated to the great painter of Trieste, died in 1944 in a nazi concentration camp.

The production during his life did not not exceed 100 works. In this anthologic exhibition will be presented around 50 of them.

The historical space of via Tor Bandena 1 will be dedicated to his works on paper, while the big space of Torbandena Projects, in via S. Nicolò 11, will host the oil paintings, selected and exhibited in seven rooms, everyone of them with a particular theme of the Artist: the Selfportraits, the animals, the metaphysics, the seascapes and so on.

For this occasion will be published a Catalogue on his Works on Paper, curated by Marilena Pasquali (director of the *Centro Studi Giorgio Morandi*), Alessandro Rosada (director of the Galleria Torbandena) and Daniele Margadonna (grandson of the artist).
